## **Guardianship and Administration involves the protection of adults who have a disability and who need a substitute decision-maker.**

The Office of the Public Advocate (as investigator or guardian), State Trustees Limited (as administrator) and VCAT (Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal) Guardianship List (having the authority to make protective orders) each have an important role.

Experienced representatives of these organisations will present an information session for persons involved in medical and allied health, social work and other relevant professions.

The session will cover when and how best to access these organisations and what else professionals can do for the cognitively impaired.

The session is free and will run for up to 1 hr 45 min, with time for questions and general discussion.
