

THE MA INGRAM TRUST FY2026 Scholarship Round Guidelines

Purpose

Support for scholarship students for the study of animals and birds of Victoria.

Funding amount

- Single scholarships of up to \$15,000

Timeframes

- Opens 16 February 2026
- Closes 13 March 2026

Outcomes

- By 13 April 2026

Eligibility

- Holders of a current research/study scholarship

What is the purpose of the Scholarship?

The purpose of the MA Ingram Trust Scholarship is to provide additional financial support to scholarship students undertaking research or education aligned with the following object:

"The preservation, and education, research and increase of knowledge with respect to the origin, history, habits, life and use, and the scientific benefits if any, of indigenous Australian (especially Victorian) mammals and birds, and the flora providing their food, cover, etc."

What is the financial value of the Scholarship?

The MA Ingram Trust Scholarships are valued at up to \$5,000 per year per successful applicant (up to 3 years).

Who is eligible?

To be eligible for a MA Ingram Trust Scholarship, applicants must:

- Provide ¹evidence that they are holders of a current scholarship
- Demonstrate that their research/studies align with the stated purpose of the Scholarship

¹Evidence of current scholarship award can be via letters of offer/confirmation from a tertiary institution.

What are the timeframes?

Applications open on Monday, February 16, 2026, and close at midnight Friday, March 13, 2026. Outcomes will be announced by Friday, April 13, 2026.
